Hi Everyone,

After another round of the virus season that refuses to go away, I have finally finished the compilation of the first of the three counts I compile, sorry for the delay.

Interesting how the numbers stack up. This was the second most diverse count in 23 years, but it was the third lowest in the number of individuals counted. 118/7663. Fifteen species had their highest individual counts, thirteen recorded the lowest individual counts, and seven unusual species were seen (species recorded 3x or less). We had ten people in six teams cover the entire 177-sq. mile circle.

Three new species were found. Two by Susan Steele at Buena Vista (Mandarin Duck and Phainopepla) and one by John Sterling (Brewer's Sparrow) at the Kern Water Bank. A quick search by Bob Barnes yielded a checklist at Buena Vista by Chet Ogan during count week that added three species (Eared Grebe, Snowy Egret, and Sage Thrasher). The table of birds is posted below my signature.

I have already begun planning next year's count and hope to have the territories fully covered for the first time in its history. I hope you can help gather support by good birders around the state and by non-birders who work at agencies and corporations within the count circle. Next year, this will be the only count I compile and hopefully I will either retire or hand off the count after the 25th Anniversary of its inception. I would love to end it with a bang.
